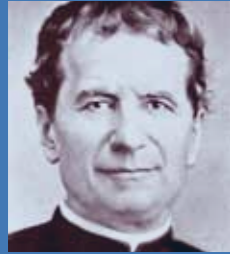

Directions

By public transport

From the central station: all the S-Bahn trains direction „Ostbahnhof“ until „Rosenheimer Platz“ underground station, follow exit „Balanstraße“
From the airport take the S-Bahn 8 direction „Geltendorf“ until „Rosenheimer Platz“ underground station.

Arrival by car or bus

By car: From the city centre take the street direction Salzburg. At „Rosenheimer Platz“ turn right into Balanstraße, then take the second street right. At the end of the street you will reach St.-Wolfgang-Platz.
By bus: From „Rosenheimer Platz“ turn right into Franziskanerstraße then turn left into Sieboldstraße and again left into Barnabastraße until you reach St.-Wolfgang-Platz.



Location

The Don Bosco Youth Hostel is located in Munich, in the Haidhausen district, just 5 min. away from the subway (S1-S8) and tram stop „Rosenheimer Platz“ (line 15 and 25).

You can reach Marienplatz in just 3 min. and the central station in 6 min. by underground.

The city district Haidhausen is more than 1.200 years old. Once it was known as the French district, today it is called „zweites Schwabing“ (Second Schwabing) because of its large number of bars and cafes and also because of its cultural facilities and its wonderful (market) squares.
